

COME TO THE EASTERCON:

The Eastercon is a supplementary conclave, with no purpose other than to provide fans with an opportunity to enjoy themselves. The Eastercon is designed to supplement the Lunacon. For details on the Lunacon look further down the page.

Both conventions are being held on the same weekend, the weekend after Easter. The Eastercon will consist of two huge parties; one on Friday April 23, 1965 and another on the next night. The party rooms will be open from 6-12 midnight both days, and will be closed on Saturday afternoon, so that attendees can go to the Lunacon.

The Eastercon will not, as previously announced, be held at the Hotel Edison. The parties are being held in room 232 of LOEW'S MIDTOWN MOTOR INN, between 48th and 49th on Eighth Avenue, a block and a half from the Edison.

The Eastercon does not have an admission fee. Anyone may come and use the rooms and facilities for free. Anyone who contributes 50¢ or more each night will receive liquor and refreshment privileges at no additional charge. People are invited to either bring their own, or drink ours, but to enjoy the social aspects of the Eastercon.

On Saturday night at 9:00 there will be an informal auction of artwork from the professional magazines. Material by Hubert Rogers, Ed Emsh and William Terry will be sold, so bring money if you are interested.
