The Disappearing Disclaimer

I am, officially, now the FAAAn Awards Administrator for Corflu 35, so this year-end “annual” of *TIR* can, I suppose, be considered at least a quasi-official Corflu publication.

“The Incompleat Register” is published as a voters’ guide and should not be considered to be a definitive list of what you can and cannot vote for. There are almost certainly both errors and omissions within, but I maintain that this is an example to not allowing the perfect to be the enemy of the good, or even of the merely adequate. My sources are primarily efanzines.com, but also paper zines personally received, and considered “publicly distributed”, (which would tend to exclude most APAzines).

A “fanzine”, for our purposes, is defined as an immutable artifact, once published not subject to revision or modification. The fanzine might not exist in a physical form. A pdf, for example, is an artifact.

Thus, fanwriters, artists and loccers listed are those who have contributed to such a publication.

Questions, comments are welcomed to the above address.

2018 FAAn Awards: Procedure

The sole criterion for eligibility for a FAAn award is that work should have been published for the first time in the calendar year 2017.

Each category invites you to vote your 1-2-3 favorites of the year. A first-place vote will be awarded 5 points, second-place 3 points, third-place 1 point. The publication or person with the highest points total receives the award.

You do NOT have to fully complete the ballot. Fill in as many (or as few) categories and slots as you are comfortable with.

You do NOT have to be a member of Corflu 35 or anything else for that matter. Voting is open to anyone with an interest in fanzines.

You do NOT have to have read or received any minimum number of fanzines to vote, although of course we encourage you to check out the contenders.

VOTING DEADLINE:

Midnight Pacific Standard Time, the Ides of March, 3/15/18. Votes sent by old-fashioned mail should be postmarked on or before that date.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

If you are voting for something or someone not listed here, please include a citation of when and where you received or read the zine, writing or artwork. This will typically be accepted on its face, but the Administrator's decision is final on whether a vote will be included. Any voter will have the opportunity to change a vote, or argue its merits, even after the voting deadline (though not too long after).

IN THE SPIRIT:

The raison d'être of the FAAns is to spread the egoboo widely. As such, voting for yourself or your own zines is considered rather not-done. However, all votes which meet our sole criterion will be accepted, albeit subject to extreme contumely via the usual gossip channels.

INTERNATIONAL FANZINE MONTH

February 2018 forms the center of the voting period, and as such I hope to publicize both fanzines in general and the awards in particular by designating it as titled.

IT COSTS YOU NOTHING

Other than perhaps a stamp if you're not voting by email. As mentioned above, it's not a requirement to be a member of the current Corflu to send in a vote, but given your interest in fanzines, I would like to suggest that you might take out a supporting membership, thereby ensuring you'll be on the mailing list for future years. 2018 FAAn Awards: Categories

GENZINE:

A fanzine which typically has multiple contributors in addition to its editor(s).

PERZINE:

A fanzine which typically has few (if any) contributors other than its editor(s).

SPECIAL PUBLICATION:

A "one-shot" fanzine.

FANWRITER:

A writer whose work has first appeared in an eligible genzine, perzine or special publication.

FANARTIST:

An artist whose work has first appeared in an eligible genzine, perzine or special publication.

LETTERHACK (HARRY WARNER, JR. MEMORIAL AWARD):

Loccer whose responses have appeared in an eligible genzine or perzine.

COVER:

Best fanzine cover of the year. A gallery will be available at efanzines.com

ONLINE ACTIVITY:

Website, blog or general online activity. See the extended comment before the category listing.

ONLINE ACTIVITY

In 2004, at Corflu Blackjack, a deserved special award was given to Bill Burns' efanzines.com website. In 2008 the category "Best Fan Website" was added to the awards. While agreeing that this might be something nice to recognize, I'm conflicted in the sense that it goes against the concept of honoring "fanzine-as-artifact" and contributors thereto, and have given serious thought to dropping the category altogether. However, it stays in for now, but expanded to include the harder-to-define and impossible-to-list "online activity", which includes blogs, online journalling, social media activity (in a fannish/fanzine context) as well as websites. I see this as a potential way to recognize writers and artists who may not necessarily have contributed to fanzines as defined here.
