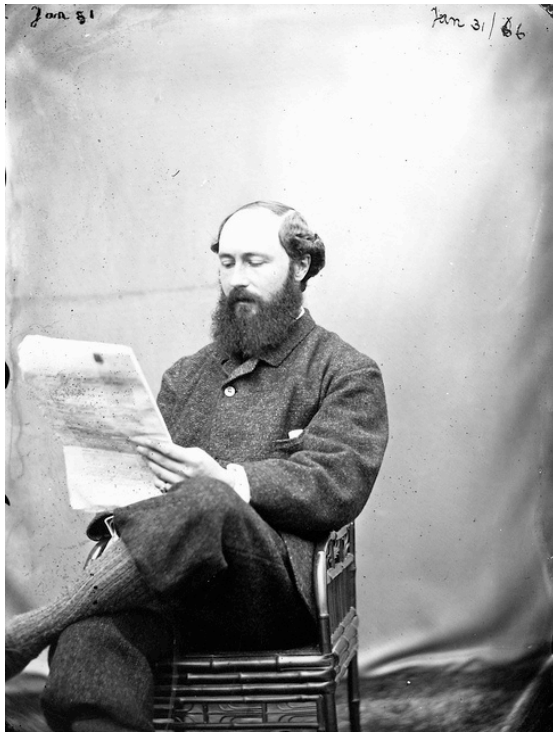

Wot?

As often seems to be the case, there's as much heated discussion (amongst those who truly care) about the FAAn Awards as there are about the Hugos, just involving fewer (and fewer) people and almost no canine conspirators.

Briefly, for those not in the know, the FAAns are fanzine fandom's own awards, currently given out at the annual Corflu convention, and voted upon by anyone with interest and (presumably) knowledge of the field; there is no other requirement to participate. Voter numbers have been declining, despite various attempts to tinker with the mechanism. This is, in part, another tinkerer's effort.

The awards were first presented in 1976 for work published the previous year, and continued for six years before vanishing until revived by Corflu 12 in 1995.

Tracy Benton noted in her writing for the corflu.org FAAn awards page that "no-one has ever produced a nigh-impossible full list of eligible zines, writers and artists for a ballot". This is also not that list.

What I've done is compiled the zines I'm aware of, mostly via efanzines.com but also paper zines received. Writers and artists are cited for what appears to be first publication (whether or not the piece was actually created in 2017), loccers are listed by number of appearances.

We're implicitly defining a "fanzine" as an immutable artifact, if you will, which once published (in whatever form) contains the fannish efforts of its contributor(s) and editor(s), which remain fixed. It's this concept of "the ish" which makes this listing possible.

It's a given that this listing will be, er, "incompleat", and also likely that there will be mistakes as well as omissions. Obviously I'd like to have these rectified with further input from readers. There are zines listed for which I don't have breakdowns of contributors and loccers, so that information would also be welcomed.

A note on categories: these listings maintain the separation between "genzines", "perzines" (with apologies to John D Berry, who hates that construction, and "one-shot/specials". The faned's self-assessment of the category in which their zine belongs would likely be considered definitive.

APAzines are a bit of a gray area. Some writers make theirs available beyond the APA, either by whim or for the usual, but they typically won't be included here.

My great thanks to Bill Burns for valuable advice and input.

WEBSITE/ONLINE ACTIVITY

The empty list, for a reason. One suggestion would be to replace the “Best Website” award with a more general acknowledgement of the harder-to-define “online activity”, which might include the management and content of various discussion groups (eg inthebar, Faaneds, various fanhistory groups), as well as individual contributions such as Ian Sales’ or Liam Proven’s Twitter feeds (two names I plucked out of the air simply because they’re longtime friends who are very skiffy), while not excluding websites like efanazines, F770, Fencyclopedia and many, many others.

The present FAAn award format still defines “Best Website” as the category, but I would like to invite suggestions for both that and the more nebulous “online activity” definition, with the idea of perhaps publishing an interim supplement to ‘The Incomplete Register’ containing the list of those recommendations.

Conversely, there’s an argument to be made whether the category should be dropped altogether to better concentrate on “the ish” and its editors, writers and artists, a view I’m rather coming around to.

FUTURE PLANS

I think it’s reasonable to attempt to publish another ish of this listzine midway between now and year’s end to provide an opportunity for further additions, comments and suggestions, as well as the “final” version for the 2017 “qualifiers” in early January.
